To estimate growth rates of Brown Crab in Northumberland, NIFCA & Newcastle University are running a tagging programme. During April 2013, sized and undersized\* Brown Crab will be tagged and released before the main moult season.



From 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013, if you catch a tagged crab please return the whole crab live with the tag intact to your usual wholesaler.

If you catch a tagged crab before 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013 please return it to the sea with the tag intact as soon as possible so that it may be re-caught after 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013.

wholesaler after 1<sup>st</sup> October 2013 you will receive  
one entry into the Diesel raffle*
