

SEA ACTIVITY AND ENFORCEMENT REPORT

SEA ACTIVITIES

St Aidan

July, Sea Patrols carried out 8 in total on 2nd 8th 10th 13th 19th 21st 24th and 27th resulting in 100 sightings being recorded. A further 2 patrols had to be cancelled on 16th and 29th.

Delta 1 was launched on 3 occasions resulting in 12 boardings being carried out and 8 sets of static gear being inspected.

Aug, Sea Patrols carried out 5 in total on 8th 10th 12th 18th and 25th resulting in 107 sightings being recorded. A further 2 patrols had to be cancelled on 6th and 27th.

Tuesday 25th Aug whilst at sea St Aidan lost part of its Starboard offside 'Spray Rail', this was reported to Goodchild Marine.

Delta 1 was launched on 1 occasion, resulting in 2 boardings being carried out and 2 sets of static gear being inspected.

Sept, Sea Patrols carried out 3 in total on 2nd 9th and 11th resulting in 73 sightings being recorded.

A further 3 sea patrols were carried out, however these were designated to camera trials on the 16th 17th and 18th.

Friday 18th Sept whilst at sea St Aidan lost part of its Starboard inner 'Spray Rail', this was also reported to Goodchild Marine, who advised that we stopped using the vessel until further notice.

Bravo1 Shore-based RIB

- July, There were 3 shore-based RIB patrols carried out this month on 14th 16th and 23rd resulting in 11 boats being boarded and 10 sets of static gear being hauled and inspected. A further day on 9th had to be cancelled.
- Aug, There was 4 shore-based RIB patrols carried out this month on the 4th 5th 13th and 26th resulting in 20 vessel being boarded and 26 sets of static gear being hauled and inspected.
- Sept, There were 3 shore-based RIB patrols carried out this month on 8th 20th and 21st resulting in 23 boats being boarded and 9 sets of static gear being hauled and inspected. A further 2 patrols were scheduled for 5th and 25th but had to be cancelled.
