NOTICE TO MARINERS - HORNSEA PROJECT ONE Deployment of Noise Monitoring Equipment

Hornsea Project One – Notice to Mariners December 2017. Issued 04/12/2017.

1. INTRODUCTION

Mariners are advised that Hornsea Project One will be commencing deployment of noise monitoring equipment in 7 locations within the offshore Wind Farm area. Hornsea Project One Offshore Wind Farm is located within the UK Sector of the North Sea off the coast of East Yorkshire. Deployment of noise monitoring equipment is expected to commence from 20th December 2017.

2. SAFETY

During deployment, the vessels detailed within this Notice to Mariners will have their ability to manoeuvre restricted. It will be requested that all vessels operating within the area keep a safe distance (500 m) and pass at minimum speed to reduce vessel wash. Operations will be conducted on a 24-hour basis. Throughout operations the vessels will be displaying the shapes and lights prescribed in the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) Rule 27. Displaying the prescribed shapes and lights when the vessel is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre.

It is requested that anybody having knowledge of any potential objects submerged or moored on the seabed, within the area of operations, that could be damaged or form a hazard to the installation vessel and its equipment advises the Project's Fishing Industry Liaison of their position and nature. When works commence a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 12 and 16 when within the appropriate port authority area, and will actively transmit an AIS signal.

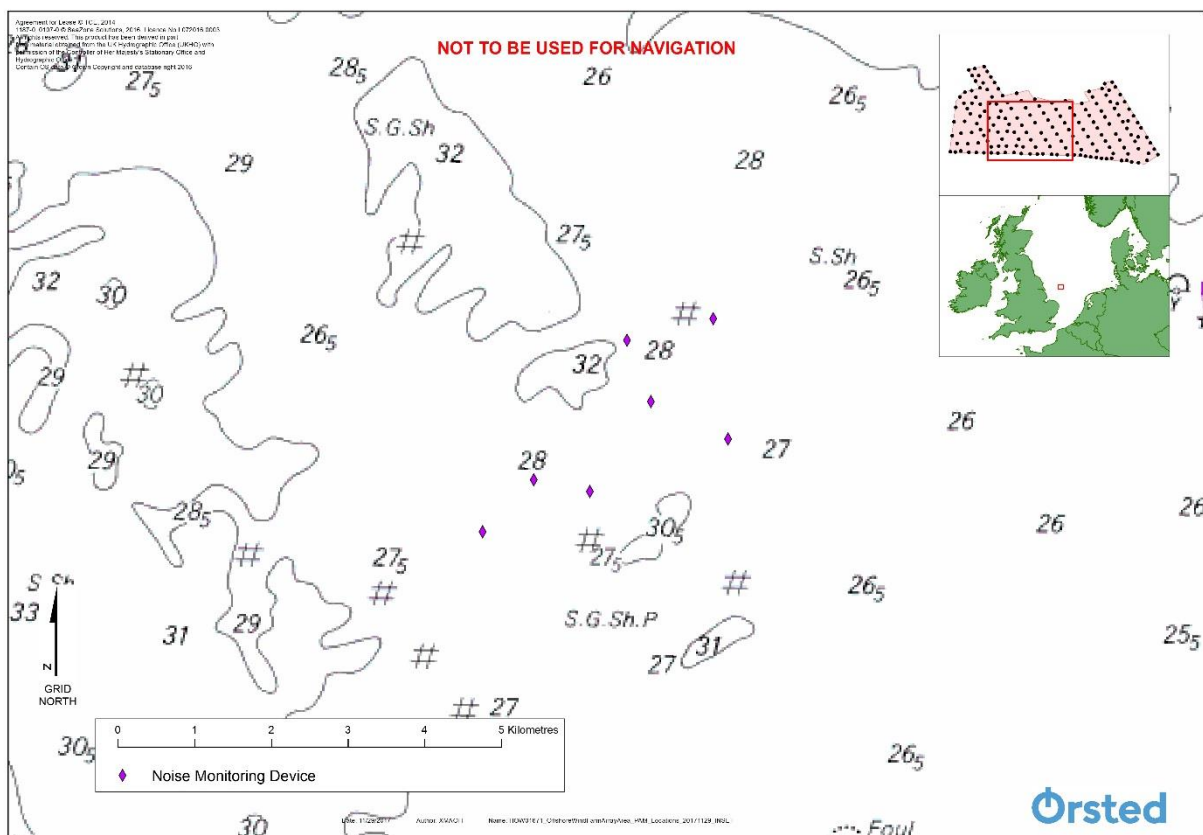



Figure 1 – Location of Noise Monitoring Equipment
