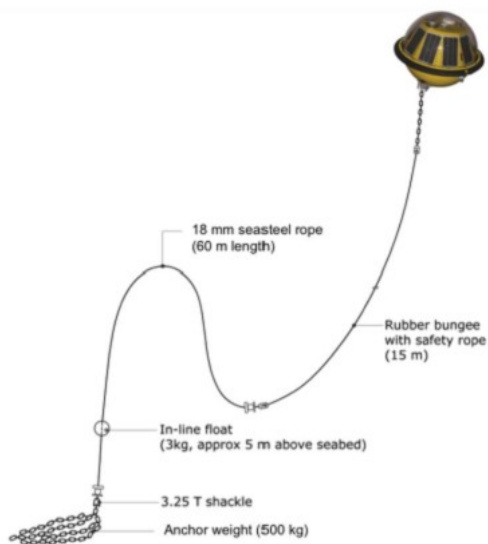

1) Update - Waverider Buoy Deployment – Blyth Offshore Windfarm Site

The BOD team plan to deploy a wave buoy on Sunday, the 19th of March, weather permitting. If the weather does not allow a safe deployment this Sunday, other attempts will be made between the 22nd and 24th of March. The waverider will be placed in position:

Latitude: 55° 08.625'N

Longitude: 001° 25.102'W



The wave rider buoy will remain in position for a period of 24 months.
