



NOTICE TO MARINERS - HORNSEA ONE PROJECT ONE Commencement of Pre lay Works for Crossing Third Party Cables/Pipelines

Hornsea Project One – Notice to Mariners February 2018. Issued 07/02/2018

1. INTRODUCTION

Mariners are advised that Hornsea Project One will be commencing pre-lay rock placement works for crossing third party cables/pipelines along the offshore export cable corridor. Hornsea Project One Offshore Wind Farm is located within the UK Sector of the North Sea off the coast of East Yorkshire. Pre-lay works will commence on or about **11 February 2018**.

2. SAFETY

It is requested that anybody having knowledge of any potential objects submerged or moored on the seabed, within the area or operations, that could be damaged or form a hazard to the rock placement vessel and its equipment, advises the Projects Fishing Industry Liaison of their position and nature.

When works commence a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 12 and 16 when within the appropriate port authority area, and will actively transmit an AIS signal. The rock placement vessel will also broadcast at regular daily intervals, vessel position, operational information and intentions.

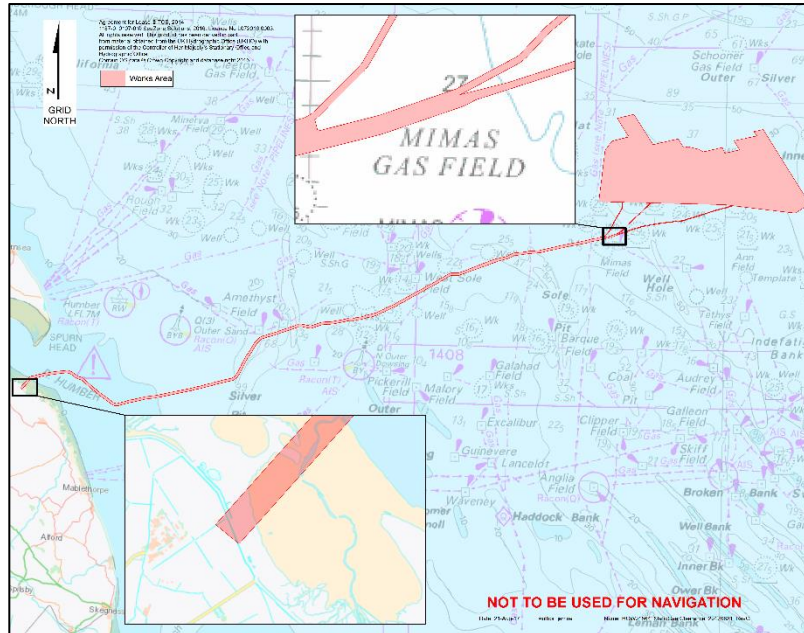

5. OPERATIONS

Activities will centre on the Hornsea Project One wind farm offshore export cable corridor.



The vessel will be deployed to offshore locations within the export cable corridor at times and positions determined by client requirements, weather and sea conditions.

The operations will commence on or about the **11 February 2018**. The exact finish date is dependent on the prevailing weather conditions, vessel downtime and work progress.

The vessel will be undertaking installation of pre lay rock protection and this will restrict its ability to manoeuvre. It will be requested that all vessels operating within the area keep a safe distance (500m) and pass at minimum speed to reduce vessel wash.

Please be advised that Tideway will be carrying out the operations with the **MV Seahorse**.

Operations will be conducted on a 24 hour basis. Throughout operations the vessels will be displaying the shapes and lights prescribed in the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (COLREGS) Rule 27. Displaying the prescribed shapes and lights when the vessel is restricted in its ability to manoeuvre.
