Recording oceanographic equipment will be moored in the vicinity of:

51°57'.17E, 002° 06'.54E

or

51.953, 2.109 (degrees decimal)

There will be a Waverider Buoy (Figure. 1) and two yellow, Class 2 Guard Buoys carrying radar reflectors (Figure. 2) at the site (Figure. 3). Both buoys are fitted with a yellow light exhibiting the sequence FI Y (5) 20s.

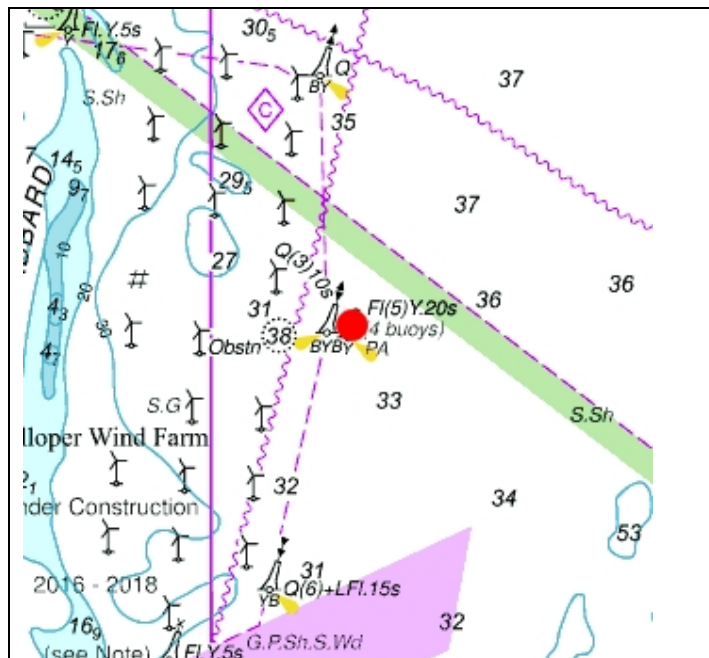
