



# Notice to Mariners – Hornsea Project Two

## Notice of Findings of Unexploded Ordnance – Issued 29/05/2019

### 1. INTRODUCTION

Hornsea Project Two is carrying out unexploded ordnance (UXO) investigations for the proposed Hornsea Project Two Offshore Wind Farm located within the UK Sector of the North Sea, off the coast of East Yorkshire as advised in 'HOW02 3001 Notice to Mariners UXO Inspection' (issued 01/04/19 and updated on 15/04/19 and 23/05/2019).

Mariners are advised that Hornsea Project Two confirms the presence of 13 confirmed unexploded ordnance (UXO) within the export cable corridor as shown in Figure 1.

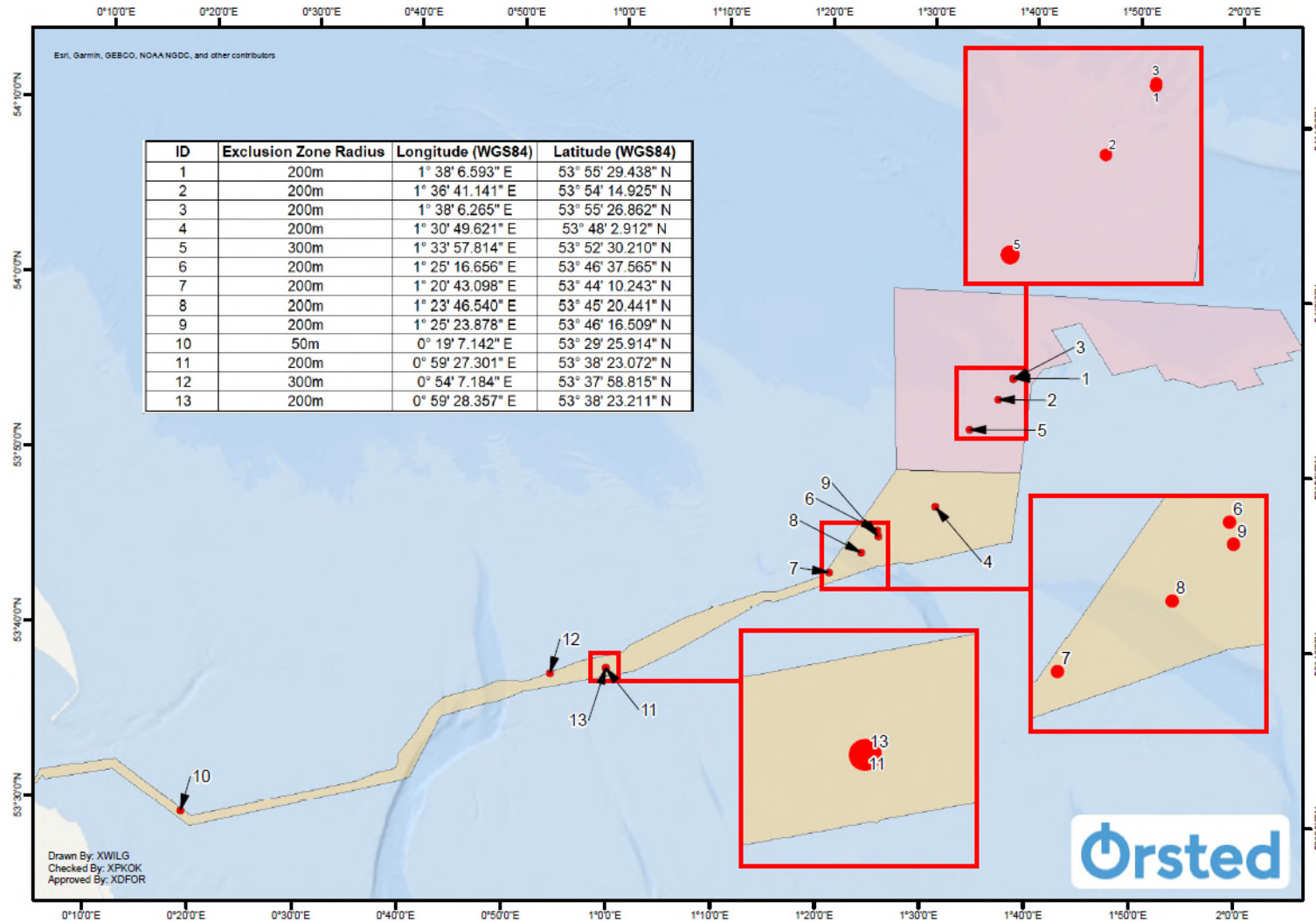
All vessels are requested to maintain the required safe distances as defined from the coordinates set out in Table 1 around the locations shown in Figure 1 below

A further Notice to Mariners will be issued closer to the time of detonation works.

During the works, a listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 12 and 16 when within the appropriate port authority area and will actively transmit an AIS signal. The survey vessels will also broadcast at regular daily intervals the vessel position, operational information and intentions.
